





Remote Projects for 2021 BYU Interns

Projects schedules are flexible and can fit students schedules as needed. The time commitment is what you should anticipate dedicating to the project, you might be able to finish faster however, we ask that you plan on that much time. You will have a weekly zoom call with your Nu Skin mentor to check in on the project and for any help or clarification. Once a month there will be a cultural experience zoom call with a staff in Malawi to learn more about the culture of Malawi. We are willing to work with college advisors for you to receive internship credit for the project. We would like to emphasize that this internship is primarily with SAFI, Nu Skin will be here to consult and advise, but you are reporting to SAFI first and foremost.

Impact Report

Major Focus: Political Science, International Relations, Public Health, Sociology Time Commitment: 10 hours per week for 2-3 months Timeline: Project can be completed between the months of May and August. SAFI Staff Mentor: Bickson – Assistant Director of Administration Nu Skin Mentor: Stephen Hunsaker

 Analyze, visualize, and compile reports for SAFI evaluations. SAFI conducts regular evaluations of their students. You would work remotely with them to take that data and help them build out an impact report. They need large reports for potential donors to show them the results of the program. This will be a longitudinal study of mixed methods. It will consist of compiling data from multiple years into summarized key takeaways and trends. It is required that you have background in data analytics and evaluation reporting. Preferably Junior or Senior.

Deliverables: Professional-looking report that can be given to donors with complied data from previous evaluations that tells a story of the success of the program.

Randomized Control Trial Report

Major Focus: Education, Political Science, International Relations, Public Health, Sociology Time Commitment: 10 hours per week for 2-3 months

Timeline: Project can be completed between the months of May and August.

 A randomized control trial was conducted in 2019 on students receiving scholarships for secondary and tertiary schooling through an initiative called Educate the Children. Staff in the field will collect the follow up data. Analyze, visualize, and report on the results of the RCT. You would work remotely with them to take the collected data and help them build out a report. You would have a mentor at BYU as well as the potential for publication. **Deliverables:** An academic formatted paper detailing the results of the RCT. This report does not have to differ from the publication format if you choose to have it published.

Gender Analysis and Policy

Major Focus: Political Science, International Relations, Sociology Time Commitment: 5-7 hours per week for 2 months Timeline: Project can be completed between the months of May and August. SAFI Staff Mentor: Esther – Monitoring and Evaluation Officer Nu Skin Mentor: Stephen Hunsaker

 Work with organization leadership to help analyze the current data on gender discrimination in Malawi and at SAFI. Compile takeaways and create a gender policy for both staff and students.

Deliverables: A policy paper that will be ratified by the SAFI board and put in place in the organization.

• Design and develop a website for SAFI

Major Focus: Graphic Design, Photography, Communications, Computer Science Time Commitment: 5-7 hours per week for 2 months

Timeline: Project can be completed between the months of May and August.

Develop a website for SAFI in order for them to increase their clout and legitimacy. They
need a website, Facebook page, and potentially an Instagram. This will allow for them to
publish the work they do and attract future donors.

Deliverables: A live website by the end of the internship with training provided by the staff to manage the website after.

Take-home sheets for SAFI Extension

Major Focus: Graphic Design, Photography Time Commitment: 5-7 hours per week for 2 months Timeline: Project can be completed between the months of May and August. SAFI Staff Mentor: Thoko – Training Coordinator Nu Skin Mentor: Stephen Hunsaker

 SAFI Extension uses a picture chart to train farms on proper farming techniques and provides them with a copy to use at home. Redesign the take-home sheets used by SAFI Extension to train their communities. These sheets currently have graphics used to explain the techniques. However, it has been determined by the staff that actual photograph of the training items will be more conducive to learning for the famers. The project will entail taking the collected photos and then designing these new sheets for the program.

Deliverables: Completed sheets with sign off by the staff mentor with raw files provided.
