Suicide Prevention Research Intern PAID POSITION!

- These positions will be responsible for entering data from our brief interviews as well as data from the youth study. We have mountains of completed protocols ready to enter into REDCap.
- One of the two positions will spend roughly a third of their time (~8 hours) assisting with study and surveillance coordination: scheduling interviews, communicating with interviewers, coordinating with other volunteers, researching phone numbers when necessary, etc.
- One of the two positions will spend roughly half of their time conducting short form interviews. At a minimum, we'd like this person to have some customer service, interviewing, or some other experience that requires asking questions and actively listening (we can train for the specifics of this work).

Other important details:

- While this is classified as an intern, any person who is interested may apply; they need not be a student/enrolled.
- The position is listed as 15 to 30 hours per week; I definitely want someone who can work closer to 30 hours per week.
- The position is part-time, non-benefited, and time-limited. The position could end as soon as June 30th, but is likely to last at least until August 19--but could be extended as far as summer 2022.
- After the training period, it *may* be possible to work from home, but working from home is not a guarantee.
- Compensation is \$18 to \$22/hourly.
