Goals:

- 1-Provide accountability to increase your productivity.
- 2-Provide opportunities to give/receive feedback to improve your writing.
- 3-Provide a setting where you can learn new techniques and practices that can make writing a positive experience.

Outcome:

- Over the course of the semester you will write a complete draft of a scientific manuscript!

Details:

- You will need a research mentor who will commit to: (1) provide guidance in identifying an appropriate writing project, (2) provide analyzed data*, and (3) support you throughout the semester by answering questions and providing prompt feedback.
- Your research mentor will determine if your writing time is paid or not.
- Activities include engaging with training videos, participating in a writing group, following day-to-day steps, and giving/receiving feedback.

*Note Data analysis is outside the scope of HLTH 492R. You can use your own data (like from a CURA) but the data will need to be analyzed by Sept 13, 2021 for you to stay on track for the semester.
