

<u>About us</u>: At Community Health Connect we help the low-income residents of Utah County receive specialty medical, dental and mental health care. This occurs through four different programs: our Volunteer Provider Network, Medicaid Enrollment, Dental Program, and Mental Health Program.

<u>Job Description</u>: The Medicaid Outreach & Enrollment Specialist is a case manager for patients with Medicaid applications, as well as an outreach coordinator who connects with community partners to find members of the community who are in need of services. They will also manage interns as part of the Title I Fluoride Program, which is conducted each Fall and Spring Semester.

Potential tasks will include:
