Integrated BS/MPH Grad Plan Approval Form Instructions

The BS/MPH Grad Plan Approval Form is required to apply to the Integrated BS/MPH program. The purpose of this form is to determine whether the BS and MPH degree coursework can feasibly be completed within two additional years. Approval to apply must be granted at both the undergraduate and graduate level. Eligible students must be BYU public health undergraduate majors with an emphasis in epidemiology, health promotion, or health science (not currently available for environmental science).

- 1. Complete the student and undergraduate degree information on page 2 before meeting with undergraduate academic advisor, Beth Liechty.
- 2. Meet with Beth Liechty (beth.liechty@byu.edu) to determine if you are eligible to apply to the integrated program. If eligible, carefully map out your public health coursework for each semester. If you are uncertain about any specific requirements, check with Beth for guidance. (Students must have at least 90 credits completed by the time they start the MPH program).
- 3. Obtain signature approval from the undergraduate academic advisor, Beth Liechty, for undergraduate approval.*
- 4. Meet with a designated MPH curriculum committee member for graduate level approval and signature.*
- 5. After completing the Integrated BS/MPH Grad Plan Approval form and obtaining the necessary undergraduate and graduate level signatures, upload the Grad Plan Approval form to the *Integrated BS/MPH Department Application* by the February 1st application deadline of your junior year.

*Grad plan workshops will be held in January 2023 to help you obtain necessary signatures in one stop for items 3 and 4 above. Please plan to attend one of these workshops. If you are unable to attend one of the scheduled workshops, please schedule times to meet with Beth and a designated MPH curriculum committee representative for the required signatures.
