BYU MPH

The Healthcare Leadership certificate seeks to prepare students for leadership and management roles in healthcare organizations. As such, completion of this certificate will prepare students to (1) demonstrate an understanding of healthcare organizations and health service delivery, (2) apply financial and business principles to a healthcare environment, (3) evaluate laws and policy regulations associated with administration in healthcare organizations, and (4) exercise leadership within healthcare organizations. Students will receive a certificate from the Department of Public Health. Completion of certificates is *not* noted on academic transcripts.

Eligibility

Only matriculated Master of Public Health (MPH) students at Brigham Young University are eligible for a leadership administration certificate.

Requirements

- 1. Students must join and participate actively in the graduate chapter of BYU's Healthcare Industry Association.
- 2. Students must complete 18 credits (12 credits of coursework plus 6-credit field experience) in order to earn the healthcare leadership certificate.

Field Experience and "R" Courses Requirements

In order to earn the healthcare leadership certificate, students need to complete a field experience (HLTH 688R) in healthcare leadership as approved by their graduate faculty advisor.

Students choosing to complete HLTH 403R – Special Topics in Public Health, HLTH 492R – Directed Public Health Readings, HLTH 603R – Special Topics in Public Health, HLTH 691R – Mentored Research, and/or HLTH 696R – Independent Studies as an elective(s) are required to focus on healthcare leadership.
