Full-Time Paid Internship: 40 hours/week, no benefits, 6-month duration

About the position:

Centro Hispano is recruiting a full-time, bilingual health educator in our Health Promotion Department. We educate in order to empower the community in making goals and plans for their future through healthy behaviors and communication skills.

Position Activities:

- Create and implement curriculum to reduce the risk of Monkeypox (MPOX) and STD/STI transmission among adolescents and adults.
- Connect with local colleges and community centers to offer MPOX and Sexual Education Classes
- Collaborate with local health clinics and providers to ensure that participants have access to MPOX and sexual health testing and treatment services.
- Plan and execute a monthly sex education class for the general public to attend, free of cost.
- Attend meetings and trainings as requested by grantors and Promotion Department Coordinator
- Represent Centro Hispano in community and partnering agency meetings and events
- Assist in developing or improving outreach materials for programing in both Spanish and English
- Plan and attend Centro Hispano sponsored events
- Attend health/community fairs hosted by local partners
- Assist Health Promotion Department Coordinator with other department and company need

The educational sessions conducted by the health educator will cover a range of topics related to Monkeypox (MPOX) and sexual health, including prevention strategies, STI education, healthy relationships, and risk reduction. These sessions will be interactive and engaging, utilizing various educational methods such as presentations, discussions, and hands-on activities. The target population for this position are young adults (18-24 years of age), adults (25-44 years of age), LGBTQIA+, Individuals with a low socioeconomic status (SES) and Hispanic/ Latinx community

Qualifications:

- Bilingual in English and Spanish (required).
- Ability and desire to engage and work with young adults (18-24 years of age), adults (25-44 years of age), LGBTQIA+ individuals, individuals with low socioeconomic status (SES), and the Hispanic/Latino community.
- 6-12 months of experience in community/public health.
- Excellent interpersonal skills.
- Comfortable contacting and following up with interested participants over email, phone, and in person.
- Outstanding oral and written communication skills.
- Comfortable discussing sexual health topics with youth, parents, and community members.
- Excellent organizational skills and attention to detail, with the ability to consistently follow through and meet deadlines.
- Highly motivated, self-starter, and passionate about the health needs of the community.
- Ability to work and contribute as part of a team.
- Must be able to work in the office 5 days a week (Monday through Friday), which

• may require evenings and weekend hours.

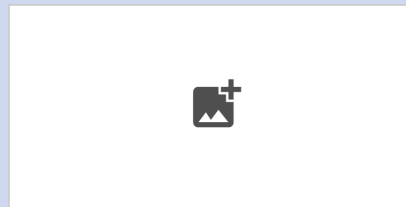
