

Entomology Internship Opportunity

Position: Entomology Intern

Location: Remote with in-person meetings as needed, with potential travel to Mali

Overview: We are seeking a highly motivated Entomology Intern at the master's level or higher to join our team and contribute to groundbreaking research in the field of entomology, specifically focusing on our Malaria Project. This internship offers a unique opportunity to work alongside experienced professionals, gain hands-on experience in entomological research, and make a significant impact in the fight against malaria and dengue fever in Mali.

Responsibilities:

- Grant Writing Assistance: Collaborate with the Malaria Project team in drafting and editing grant proposals aimed at securing funding for vital research initiatives.
- Data Evaluation: Work closely with the Malaria Project Manager to acquire, analyze, and interpret data related to mosquito vector behavior and malaria transmission dynamics.
- Public Engagement: Represent the Malaria Project at fundraising events, engaging with stakeholders and donors to communicate the project's objectives, progress, and impact.
- Impact Reporting: Prepare detailed reports for our Global Giving Platform, outlining the tangible impact of the Malaria Project on the communities and individuals affected by malaria in Mali.
- Fieldwork in Mali: Travel to Mali to assist with field research activities, including mosquito sampling, data collection, and collaborative efforts with local communities and research partners.

Qualifications:

- Currently pursuing or completed a master's degree or higher in Entomology, or a related field with a focus on vector-borne diseases.
- Experience in grant writing, data analysis, and scientific report writing preferred.
- Strong communication skills, both verbal and written, with the ability to engage effectively with diverse audiences.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team in a dynamic and multicultural environment.
- Flexibility and willingness to travel internationally, specifically to Mali, for fieldwork assignments.
